

Comments on remote from SACLA facility

- For foreign users, conventional experimental style with “**fully local participation**” could be performed hopefully by the end of this year.
- But “**hybrid**” style (i.e., limited number of users in SACLA; majority in remote) looks very promising and productive. We expect that this becomes one of the major choices for international users.
 - Reduction of travel expense of large-group users
 - Could promote collaboration among international users and Japanese universities/institutes
 - Japanese students can find more chances to participate in SACLA’s experiments through international collaboration
- “**Full remote**” style (i.e., no users in SACLA) is possible, but only applicable to standard setups with eliminating any complicity. We do not encourage it, unless users could not find any alternatives.
 - SACLA does not have sufficient resources of BL staff to “operate” user experiments. This boundary is similar to those in SR facilities, but different from that of LCLS or EuXFEL.
